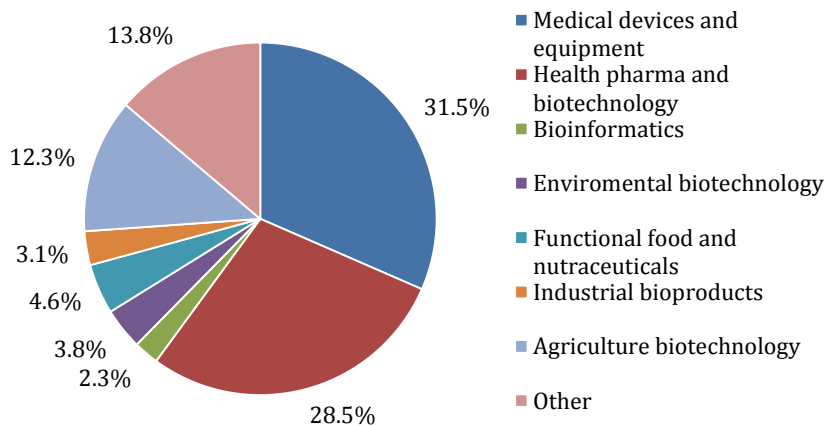


In any economy, the creation of a bio venture is a complex process. Choosing where to incubate your concept, or expand an established company is a crucial decision.
