LIFE SCIENCES IN NOVA SCOTIA



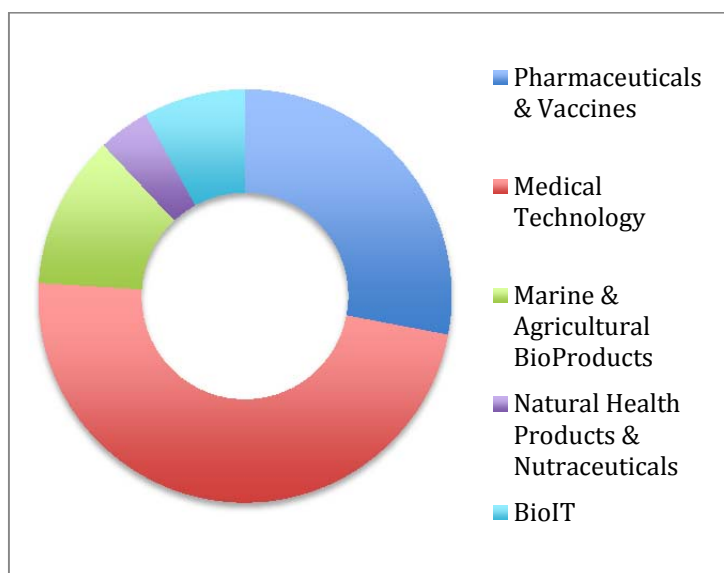
